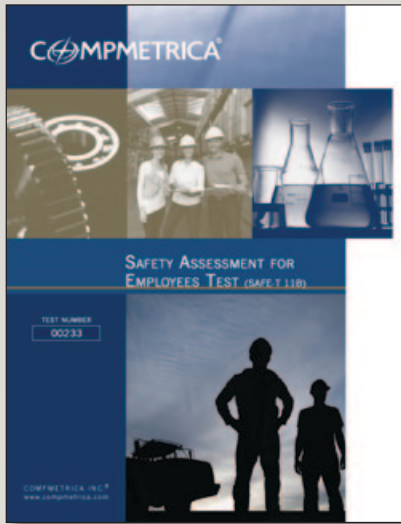


COMP METRICA Safety Assessment for Employees Test



The **Safety Assessment for Employees Test (SAFE-T)** is an assessment tool designed to measure the factors associated with safe behaviours of employees in organizations. The test has been developed based on scientific and professional studies that have identified the personal aspects having an impact on health and safety in the workplace. SAFE-T assesses all of these aspects, which are: attitudes, motivations, perceptions and personal characteristics.

Description

- The SAFE-T test measures the following four (4) factors related to employee safety practices and behaviours: Personal characteristics, motivation, safety attitudes, and safety outlook.
- This test is composed of two parts:
Part 1: One hundred and four (104) statements which the candidate must answer by determining to what extent he/she agrees or disagrees with each one of them.
Part 2: Four (4) short situations where the candidate must indicate the relative importance of each of the four (4) factors.

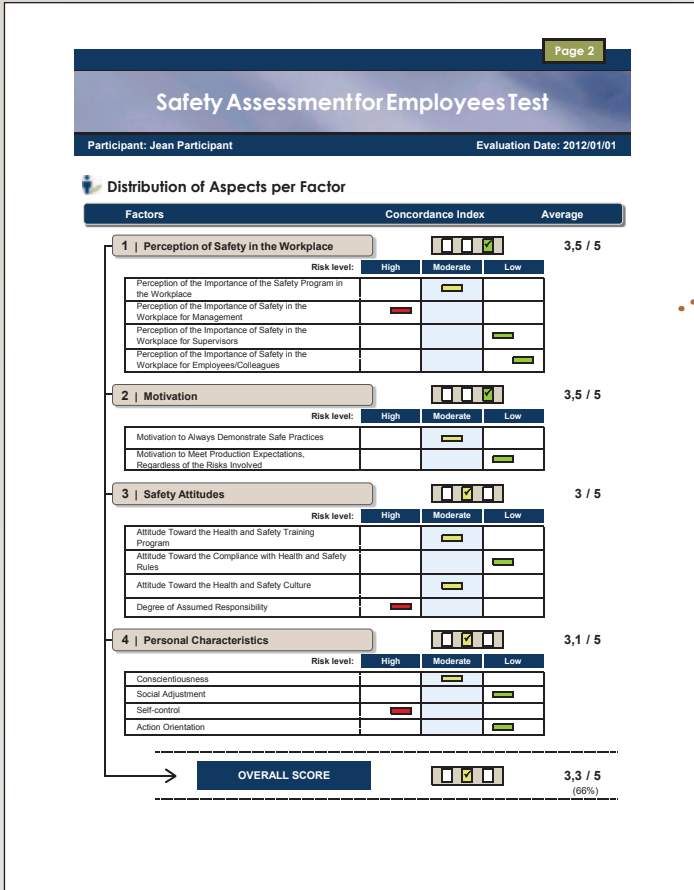
